Summer Street – Rea Street to Salem Street

Elm Street – Main Street to Water Street

Francis Street – Patriot Street to Baldwin Street

Lexington Street – Pleasant Street to Concord Street

May Street – Main Street to Hodges Street

Raleigh Tavern Lane – full length

Old Clark Road – full length

Baldwin Street – Francis Street to Gilbert Street

Essex Street – Great Pond Road to town line

Waverly Road – Greene Street to Mass Ave

Waverly Road – Turnpike St to Town Line

South Bradford Street – Great Pond Road to Winter Street

Winter Street – South Bradford Street 630 feet in the direction of Morningside Lane

High Street – Water Street to Prescott Street

Bradford Street – Route 125 up the hill 110 feet

SEWER PROJECTS

Waverly Road Sewer Project – project complete – paving complete – line striping to be done when paving is finished from the Andover town line to Mass Ave.

Sutton Street Sewer

Replace Sewer Main along Bill McEvoy (Chadwick) Playground on Sutton Street. Install Odor Control Structures on Sutton Street near Thorndike Road.

Eastside Sewer Replacement Project

Replace trunk sewer in easement between NA Mills and Clean Harbors off Sutton Street.

Old Westside Sewer Project

Root removal and slip line installation on trunk sewer in easement between Mass Ave and Marblehead Street, along the Shawsheen River and Rte 495.
